**This event is organised in conjunction with the South Of Reading Christian Fellowship and will be led by men who have a vision to bless and encourage the wider body of Christ. The Bible Week will especially appeal to those who have a burden to see the raising of biblical standards in this country and in the Church, with a balance between the Word and the Spirit, the place of Israel and the return of Christ in the purposes of God.**

The Bible Week is aimed at the whole Family of God and we welcome families, married couples and singles. All ages are catered for. Come as a Church or on your own and receive a welcome.

## Speakers so far confirmed are: -

**John Angliss** - Reading. John has pastored the South Of Reading Christian Fellowship for 35 years. His ministry is cutting edge teaching of the whole counsel of the Word of God, specialising on Israel and End Times from a prophetic point of view. He has ministered widely in this country as well as abroad.

**Ken Burnett** - Founder of the international 'Prayer For Israel' network, and its Director for 36 years, (with the focus on praying for Messianic Fellowships in Israel), and has relinquished his administrative role a few years ago, but continues to share more of God's truth about Israel.

**Mike Gomm** - Reading. Mike is Classroom ICT Advisor at a large comprehensive school in Reading and teaches ICT and Physics and often has opportunities to share about life from a biblical perspective. He has been a member of South of Reading Christian Fellowship since 1983 and he administers the Bible Week with Helen.

**Nigel Thompson** - Reading. Nigel's primary calling is that of the Evangelist with a gifting of breaking bondages and setting captives free. His heart is for the lost, Church planting, and he has ministered in several countries.



At the time of going to press other key people have been invited to speak but have yet to confirm their attendance and we anticipate other like-minded groups and organisations joining us for this week.

The praise and worship will be led by a team of musicians from a number of Churches.

The programme for most days will include two morning sessions of bible teaching and then an evening "celebration style" meeting. There will be Children's Ministry running during the morning and this is divided into two groups, a younger "first fruits" group for the under fives and the main ministry for those who are five and have complete the first year at primary school. This will be led by John and Junko McCrossan from Ireland. The youth will have their own meetings led by Greg Husband and team. The age for youth is 12+ (ie. those who have completed year 7 at secondary school).

The week will commence with the first main meeting on the Saturday and conclude after Friday evening's meeting. People must be off site by 12.00 noon on the Saturday.

Top Barn is run by a Christian family and is beautifully kept, bordering onto the River Severn and provides facilities for walking, coarse fishing, and sailing. There is also a maize maze on site.

The main camping field is almost flat with a number of electrical hookup points and the Childrens Marquee is situated at the edge of this field.

The main marquee is very close and will be divided to provide an area for refreshments and fellowship where teas, coffees and light snacks will be sold. There is a hospitality marquee available for use between meetings and car parking for those off site.

We are please to announce that a British Sign Language stage 3 interpreter will be available for some of the meetings to help where necessary.

There are toilet and showering facilities and there is the very popular Harvest Farm shop which is renowned for its produce over a large area. The prices compare favourably with local supermarkets.

There is good local accommodation for those who do not wish to camp and a summary list is available or from the Worcester Tourist information office on 01905 726311. We also have details of tent and caravan hire.

The afternoons will be free for you to fellowship on site or to explore this delightful part of the country to Worcester and beyond. There will be meetings every evening.

## Location of Top Barn

**Top Barn is located on the A443 between Worcester and Holt Heath.**

For most people leave the M5 at junction 6 and take the A449 northwards towards Kidderminster. After about 7 miles leave the A449 at Ombersley. Those from the north may wish to leave the M5 at junction 5 take the A38 south and then take the A4133 to Ombersley from the Droitwich Spa ring road. From Ombersley take the A4133 to Holt Heath (2 miles). Turn left onto the A443 south towards Worcester and the Top Barn entrance will be found on your left after about a mile. Turn in here.

Follow the roadway past the farm shop (beware of the road humps) and bear left just past the CL camping site and the entrance to the sailing lake. Going past the farmyard, bearing right up the hill to our site. On arrival please park just off the road in front of the Children's Marquee and follow the signs to registration.

Further information will be sent to you on receipt of a booking form. The postcode of Top Barn is WR6 6NH.
